NEW BUILDING VESSEL - SITE MANAGER

for the supervision of two 82,600dwt Kamsarmax type bulk carriers' construction,

The intent of the role is to supervise the construction of the new vessels, ensuring that all activities are conducted safely, efficiently, and to the highest quality standards. On a daily basis the Site Manager is expected to lead and manage a team of steel, painting, and machinery supervisors, ensuring compliance with building contract, specifications, and Plan Comments Forms. The Site Manager will liaise with the shipyard teams, respecting the local work ethics, and ensuring smooth cooperation at all levels. Will also maintain close cooperation with class site office ensuring full compliance with class requirements on regulatory as well as practical onsite level. The Site Manager will be under direct guidance of the Neda Head office technical department, report to it and follow company's policies and procedures on newbuilding projects.

The role's key responsibilities are:

- Oversee and manage the daily operations at the construction site.
- Ensure all activities comply with safety regulations and company policies.
- Manage site office personnel issues and maintain site office expenses within budget.
- Monitor progress and prepare weekly reports.
- Manage and resolve any issues or conflicts that arise on-site, always keeping head office informed.
- Ensure the quality of work meets the specified standards and requirements.
- Conduct regular site inspections jointly or alone with site office steel, painting, machinery supervisors as required.
